Lucy Estelle Doheny, 21, granddaughter of the late Edward L. Doheny, Sr., oil magnet, was to be married today at 4:30 p.m. to Waldeman Van Cott Niven, 25, an attorney.

With Bishop W. Bertrand Stevens of the Los Angeles Episcopal Diocese officiating, the ceremony was to be performed in the Doheny home at 501 Doheny Rd., Beverly Hills, and was expected to be the most brilliant of the social season.

A dance and reception were to follow the ceremony, after which the bridal couple were to sail on the S. S. Lurline for a wedding voyage to Hawaii.
