

Mrs. A. H. Boyd Leaves Estate Worth \$80,000

An estate estimated at \$80,000 was left by Rose H. Boyd, who conducted a dressmaking establishment at 301 Tenth street S, according to her will filed in probate court today. She died Nov. 25. The will requests that the business be discontinued.

The major portion of the estate is left to her husband, Alexander H. Boyd. Bequests of jewels are made to relatives in Minneapolis and at Adrian, Mich., and she left \$500 in trust for the education of a child in whom she took a friendly interest. She remembered three employees with gifts of \$100, \$200 and \$300 respectively.

Under the name of Madame Boyd, Mrs. Boyd conducted a dressmaking business in Minneapolis for many years.
