## FORD COAL BOATS TO ARRIVE SOON

### Dock Superintendent Ordered to Make Ready for Cargoes.

Shipments of coal to the Ford dock at Thirty-seventh av W will start about April 25, James Patten, superintendent of the dock, announced Friday.

Mr. Patten received word Friday from Detroit instructing him to prepare for the season. The Ford boats, Henry Ford II and Benson Ford, will start loading at lower lake ports within a few days.

Last year the two boats made 20 trips to the Duluth dock, unloading approximately 250,000 tons of coal. There is about 75,000 tons of coal at the present time at the dock, according to Mr. Patten.
