

Rites Set for Ex-Store Head Arthur Letts Jr.

Private funeral services for Arthur Letts Jr., 68, retired merchant and scion of a pioneer Los Angeles family, will be conducted at 11 a.m. tomorrow in Hollywood Memorial Park chapel, with Pierce Bros. Hollywood mortuary officiating.

Mr. Letts, onetime president and executive officer, respectively, of the Broadway and Bullock's department stores here, died Sunday in Good Samaritan Hospital.

Born in Seattle, Mr. Letts came here as a youngster with his father, founder of the two merchandising firms, and remained active in the businesses until about 25 years ago when the family relinquished its interests in both enterprises.

He made his home at 10236 Charing Cross Rd.

Since his retirement he had devoted his energies to civic work and maintained memberships in the California and Los Angeles Country Clubs.

He leaves his widow Margot G., and two sisters, Mrs. Gladys Pollock and Mrs. Edna McNaughton, both of Los Angeles.
