Hugh Hefner Buys Louis Statham Estate

One of the largest singlefamily residential sales in the history of California was consummated when Playboy publisher Hugh M. Heffner bought the Beverly Hills estate of industrialist physicist -Louis B. Statham for more than \$1 million.

The estate, in Holmby Hills, midway between Bel Air and Beverly Hills, consists of a 30-room Tudor house with steeppitched slate roof, turrets and Gothic arches on approximately five acres

partly adjoining the Los Angeles Country Club. It was built in 1927 by architect Arthur Kelly for the late Arthur Letts Jr., son of the founder of the Broad way Department Stores.

Under Statham's ownership the estate has been the headquarters and hospitality residence of Les Dames de Champagne of Los Angeles, a non-profit hostess corps which welcomes visiting dignitaries on a personal and social level, supplementing

government programs.
