

NELS C. BEIM

A retired Minneapolis businessman, Nels C. Beim, 90, formerly of 1601 W. 22nd St., died Sunday. Services will be at 2:30 p.m. Wednesday in St. Paul's Episcopal Church, with burial in Lakewood Cemetery.

Mr. Beim, a native of Bergen, Norway, lived in St. James, Minn., before moving to Minneapolis in 1908. He was associated with the former Twin City Oil Co. He joined the W. H. Barber Co. in 1914 and was president and chairman of the board for 25 years.

He was director and member of the executive committee of the Midland National Bank for 24 years before retiring in 1960.

Mr. Beim was a member of St. Paul's Episcopal Church, a 32nd degree Mason, a Scottish Rite, Shriner and charter member of Joppa Lodge. He was a former member of the Minneapolis Rotary Club, Lafayette Club, Town and Country Club and Minneapolis Club.
